## The role of energy efficiency against fuel poverty

Friday, June 23, 2017 - Lateranensis Pontifical Academy - Room 103

### Purpose

Energy Poverty means lack of access to appropriate, reliable and secure energy sources at affordable prices to meet the basic needs of individuals, such as eating, space heating, transportation.

The reduction of energy poverty in the countries is a necessary condition to promote economic development and social dignity. We must provide an effective response to energy poverty by strengthening the position of vulnerable consumers and the development of corrective measures to enable poor people to obtain energy at affordable costs. In this sense, the European Directive on energy efficiency and the latest documents of the European Commission (Winter Package) urged member states to develop programs to sensitize individuals and families and to provide them with information and advice on energy efficiency, establishing de facto the principle that energy efficiency is an important tool in the fight against poverty.

It is important to define a strategy against energy poverty, proposing a transversal area of cooperation at various geographical levels, between the various ministries, and to identify a number of measures including: defining appropriate socio-economic indicators; identification of the interventions to be carried out; establishment of a special social fund for energy improvement.
